When I opened this link, I found that the Department is seeking 5 vendors (one for each borough) to manage their Home Care program. Unfortunately, after reviewing the application, I found no suggestion that the department would consider the inclusion of the Consumer Directed philosophy in their program. An absence that is a significant programmatic deficiency, if the objective of the proposal is to provide a service in a manner that minimizes cost and maximizes Consumer Independence and Satisfaction. According to the Eldercare News video Consumer-Directed Home Care: Washington & Beyond. Part 2 Seniors who have the opportunity to select a Consumer Directed option have a higher level of satisfaction than people who receive services through the traditional agency based model. It is my hope that at some point the NYC Department for the Aging will address the communities growing desire for empowerment by incorporating a Consumer Directed component in their program.
