Fighting for Community First Choice: Advocates in the News

Yesterday, disability advocates from ADAPT, NYAIL, CDPAANYS and several Independent Living Centers visited the New York State Assembly and Senate to advocate for the Community First Choice Option. Advocates occupied the Assembly chambers for hours, stopping the session, while simultaneously maintaining a presence outside of the Senate's session. Many Assemblymembers were responsive; including Assemblywoman Gunther and Assemblyman Morelle who tried to negotiate with advocates to leave with a promise the Assembly would address the issue on Monday. We understand the Democratic Conference did meet for nearly an hour yesterday to discuss CFC as a result of the action. Eventually Bruce Darling, Lindsay Miller, Bryan O'Malley, and Sue Ruff secured a closed door meeting with Assemblywoman Gunther and Assemblywoman Deborah Glick, chair of the Higher Education Committee. Unfortunately the Assemblywomen and staff were not willing to discuss the substantive issues still being debated during the three way negotiations, and could only offer a commitment that they are working on the issue. With no resolution or strong commitment, ultimately 17 advocates were arrested for refusing to leave the Capitol after it closed at 7pm. It is our understanding three way negotiations will continue, but thus far there is still no definitive movement from either the Senate or the Assembly on CFC. There are only seven days left until the end of session, and the bill must be introduced by Monday in order to be voted on this year. There was a lot of attention on the protest in the media, and requests are still coming in for interviews and comments. **Let's capitalize on this response and build more media attention! Contact your local media outlet to discuss the issue.**
