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## **Disabled Glen Spey Man Battles State**

Agency plans to limit hours of home health aides

**GLEN SPEY** — Michael Mulhern has a disability, but by no means is he helpless.

Mulhern was left blind and paralyzed by an off-duty NYPD cop's bullet during a barroom confrontation 37 years ago. Today, at 59, Mulhern is happily married, uses technology ably and keeps his keen mind engaged by "fighting the establishment all day long," he said.

His latest fight is with the New York State Department of Health, which is changing its rules in response to the federal Fair Labor Standards Act to limit the number of hours home health aides can work - including those assisting Mulhern and his wife, Jeannine, who is disabled with hip and knee problems.

The Mulherns each receive care around the clock under the Consumer Directed Personal Assistance Program. CDPAP, as the program is known, allows the couple

to remain in their own home, a small ranch in Glen Spey with a wraparound deck and a wishing well in the front yard. They have two dogs, four birds and a cadre of personal assistants who cook, clean and shop for the couple, as well as attend to their personal needs.

Such a situation is a win-win, many say, because it's more beneficial and more cost-effective to care for people with severe disabilities in their own homes than to put them in nursing homes or other long-term care facilities.

The Mulherns solicit and hire their own staff through two agencies; they employ seven personal assistants who work anywhere from eight- to 16-hour shifts - typically totaling more than 40 hours per week, per employee. But beginning Jan. 1, the state Department of Health will limit its funding to CDPAP, the program that pays for those assistants, to allow for a maximum of 40 hours per week, per employee, per agency. That change will effectively force the couple, and countless others like them, to contract with additional agencies and hire more people to deliver the same care, the Mulherns say.

While they're not being denied care, the Mulherns say the limitation makes an already complicated situation more complex.

"It's going to be impossible to get that many people out here to work for us," Jeannine Mulhern said of their remote location in Sullivan County. "It's not going to happen."

Casey Cassidy, 23, of Newburgh has worked in the couple's home since August, earning \$11 an hour straight time; she works 69 hours a week, and said a reduction by the state would force her to get a second job.

Assemblywoman Aileen Gunther, D-Forestburgh, said that while "we all believe in fair labor practice, there's been a precedent set for those longer shifts. In hospital settings, nurses and nurses' aides routinely work 12-hour shifts, and they don't get overtime. They know this; that's what they sign up for." Gunther is a registered nurse with 29 years' experience.

Andre Bowser, a spokesman for the U.S. Department of Labor, which enforces the Fair Labor Standards Act, said, “States have a number of options for bringing their programs into compliance.”

For example, Bowser said, some states are planning to increase funding for home care programs to ensure workers receive overtime pay for workweeks over 40 hours. Others, such as New York, are planning to limit overtime work. Bowser said states have the option of creating exceptions so that certain patients “can still receive care from a single home care worker in excess of the general cap on worker hours.”

Officials with the state Department of Health did not return phone calls and emails by the Times Herald-Record seeking comment.

“This dire situation can be remedied only through an increase in Medicaid funding for CDPAP,” state Sen. John Bonacic, R-Mount Hope, wrote in a Nov. 21 letter to state Health Commissioner Howard Zucker. “In the most recent budget resources were set aside ... to solve this problem. However, it is wholly within the Department of Health’s powers to determine where such funds are actually used.”

Michael Mulhern said he’ll keep fighting until the cap is lifted.

“I learned to survive,” said Mulhern, who still wears the dog tags the Navy issued him when he enlisted in 1972. “I learned to adapt. I learn by hearing and doing. But what about the men and women who are older, who need more care and can’t advocate for themselves? I think everything is going to be solved eventually, but not till after people are forced into a nursing home.”
