US SENATE FAILS TO PASS DISABILITY TREATY (CRPD)

US SENATE FAILS TO PASS DISABILITY TREATY; ALIENATES DISABILITY BASE UNDER SHADOW OF FISCAL CLIFF

ADAPT joins the rest of the disability community in expressing our deep disappointment that the majority of Republican Senators voted against ratifying the Convention on the Rights of People with Disabilities (CRPD).

Whatever the individual rationale, this vote is a slap in the face against the community integration principles that are the foundation of the ADA and the disability community which has worked so hard to secure ratification of this treaty.

Disability rights advocates were hopeful that the Republican party, which in 1990 joined with Democrats to pass the ADA, would do so again in 2012 to pass the CRPD. We were wrong. In the wake of the election, the Republicans need to engage people with disabilities. This vote has just produced the opposite effect.

Many of the ideas we support are consistent with the party's philosophy, but the Republican Senators who voted against the treaty would apparently rather represent the interests of the extreme elements in their party rather than include all PWDs and our families and friends, said Marsha Katz of MT ADAPT.

Although the Senate voted against ratifying the CRPD, disability advocates point out that the negotiations on the fiscal cliff give Republicans another opportunity to demonstrate that they want to broaden their base and engage the disability community. The fiscal cliff threatens not only healthcare services that PWDs need but the services and supports that allow people to live their daily lives. Republicans have been calling for entitlement reform that arbitrarily cuts Medicaid through block grants which will have a devastating impact on PWDs.

Medicaid funding assures that PWDs are provided necessary health care, but Medicaid also funds the services and supports that allow people with disabilities to perform the most basic tasks needed for daily living, including getting in and out of bed, bathing, dressing, cooking and eating, said Bruce Darling of Rochester ADAPT. We call on the nation to join the MY MEDICAID MATTERS campaign and fight for this funding.

ADAPT's MY MEDICAID MATTERS proposes real Medicaid reform that would contain spending while modernizing Medicaid so that PWDs have greater control over their lives and be able to live in the community rather than be forced into institutions. www.adapt.org/main/medicaid_rally/medicaid_savings)

Now that the vote on the CRPD is done, Republicans in Congress have a fundamental choice. They can embrace ADAPT's proposals for true entitlement reform and broaden their base to include people with disabilities or they continue to represent the interests of party extremists and push PWDs off the fiscal cliff, said Bob Kafka of ADAPT of TX.

Republicans Largely Ignore Dole's Exhortation on Disabilities Treaty

The wheelchair-bound, 89-year-old former Senate majority leader, GOP presidential nominee and World War II veteran was escorted onto the floor Tuesday by his wife, former Sen. Elizabeth Dole, R-N.C., to rally support for the United Nations disabilities treaty.

Last week, he was being treated at the Walter Reed National Medical Military Center. This week, he was trying to buttonhole colleagues to support an initiative to extend the rights granted to Americans under the Americans with Disabilities Act to citizens of the world. Dole was gravely injured during World War II when his right arm was shattered in battle and he has been a longtime advocate for the rights of the disabled, particularly veterans.

One by one, Senators of both parties approached the frail national leader, with former colleagues gently resting their hands on his shoulder or reaching out to his left hand, briefly clasping the man who once presided over the chamber with a mix of wit, tactical guile and ruthlessness. Then, one by one, after Dole was wheeled off the floor, most Republicans voted against the measure.

Dole's dramatic appearance did not secure the votes of the 13 Republicans needed to ratify the treaty. In fact, only eight members of the caucus he once led joined Democrats to back U.N. Convention on the Rights of Persons With Disabilities, which would have expanded rights to disabled people globally.

Several conservative groups, Glenn Beck and former Sen. Rick Santorum, R-Pa., opposed the treaty because they said it would allow the U.N. to overreach and impose on the rights of member countries.

The Republican Senators voting for the measure were:

Kelly Ayotte of New Hampshire,
John Barrasso of Wyoming,
Scott P. Brown of Massachusetts,
Susan Collins and Olympia J. Snowe of Maine,
Richard G. Lugar of Indiana,
Lisa Murkowski of Alaska, and
John McCain of Arizona.

Sen. Thad Cochran, R-Miss., changed his vote from a "yes" to a "no" after it was obvious the treaty would fall short of ratification. Cochran is up for re-election in 2014 and could face a primary challenge from his right.

Other Republicans who could face primary challenges from the right this cycle but who might have made the difference on the vote also voted against the treaty:

Saxby Chambliss of Georgia,
Lindsey Graham of South Carolina, and
Lamar Alexander of Tennessee.

After the vote, Heritage Action for America CEO Michael A. Needham released the following statement: "We congratulate the Senators who stood for American sovereignty by refusing to ratify this treaty. While today's vote is important, it does not mark the end of the fight. Bad treaties never die in Washington and Heritage Action will remain vigilant."

Last week on the floor, Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid, D-Nev., characterized Dole's health status as "infirm." The current majority leader had a brief conversation with the former majority leader before the roll was called.
